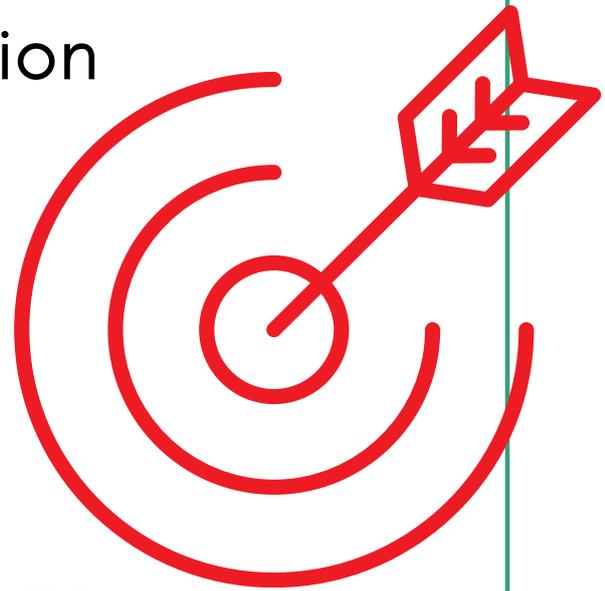
In 1948, the Naturefriends movement developed and implemented the idea of a Naturefriends Day around the foundation date of the movement on 16th of September 1895. A main reason for setting up this day was the fact, that the Naturefriends movement could only survive the era of fascism in many European countries with the help of the member organisations in other countries, such as Naturefriends Switzerland or Naturefriends in the United States.

This tradition of holding a Naturefriends Day has never been lost, and many member organisations celebrate a Naturefriends Day in September. However, the international aspect has increasingly taken a back seat.

The NFI Annual Conference 2018 decided to revive the idea of Global Naturefriends Days focusing on internationality, solidarity, and nature. At the 2021 Annual Conference the delegates decided “**Nature and Solidarity**” as the overall motto for the activities. This general motto gives the national organisations and local groups the necessary room for implementing their own activities, and at the same time, ensures the communication of the core values of our movement.

Why Organize a Climate Hike?

- **Raise awareness** about climate change and sustainability in a relaxed, inclusive setting.
- **Engage diverse participants:** young people, families with children, single-parent families, people with reduced mobility etc.
- **Promote wellbeing:** both mental and physical, through time spent outdoors.
- **Encourage discussion** on important topics like the influence of climate change on local flora, fauna and landscape, climate friendly behaviour, renewable energies, or local environmental challenges.
